Additional, to our last update on Friday 06/03/2020,

As part of our plan to encourage good hygiene standards, we would like to inform you of the following:

- Staff, children and visitors are requested to wash their hands:
 - before leaving home
 - on arrival at KCA
 - after using the toilet
 - after breaks and sporting activities
 - before food preparation
 - before eating any food, including snacks
 - before leaving school
 - and as frequently as required

- Furthermore, staff are supporting children to wash their hands on arrival at KCA. To support children developing hygienic routines, please encourage this activity at home as well. Where there is no access to clean water and soap, or accessing a toilet is difficult due to long queues, then use hand sanitizer (hand antiseptic).
